f SOE provided a summary of UAAC queries and provided documentation for alignment with the Core. In advance of the meeting, Ellen Crowell provided recommendations and feedback to SOE for meeting Core requirements core articulations to share.

- x Do we need to meet more often November/February? This would require a by-law change.
- x Revisit discussion around microcredentials.
 - o Are students able to count too much? Is there an excessive amount of credit overlap between academic programming (i.e., major, minor, micro-credential courses)?
 - o Are we deluding the value of a microcredential?
 - o Consider inserting some language that microcredentials must consist of unique courses with a minimum of six courses.
 - o Are there parameters on how many microcredentials a student can earn.
 - o Is this creating more anxiety for students wanting to achieve as many credentials as possible? Ultimately it is the decision of the student and their expectations for level of success
